### **For your information**

Dear Mr. Plenderleith,

Last year you turned to me with an application to check whether in the preparation of the methodology “Recommendations for calculating the price for water service” the Competition Authority complied with the principle of ensuring fundamental rights and freedoms and due process. As you are aware, my position is that the Competition Authority has violated the due process towards you with regard to the part in which in the engagement notice it had marked a misleading purpose of engagement to the people not included in the administrative process. Also, as you are aware, I recommended the CA in the future when engaging people not included in the administrative process to mark clearly in the notices addressed to the parties engaged for which purposes the engagement is organised and what is the role of the parties engaged.

I would hereby like to inform you that in the course of the follow-up proceedings I checked, whether and how the CA has agreed to follow my recommendation. As a result of that it appeared that the CA agrees to follow my recommendation in any further engagement of the persons not included in the administrative procedure. I also forward hereby for your information the CA’s response which reiterates the above.
